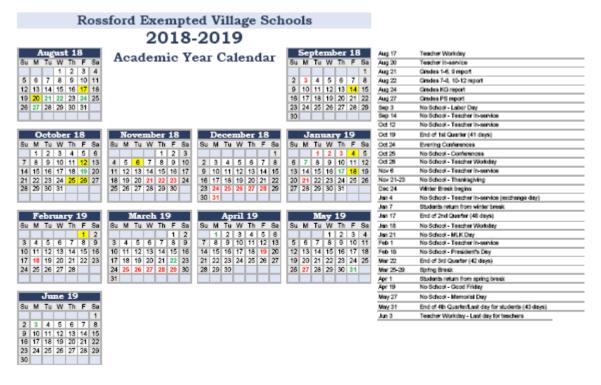
Revenue vs. Expenditures for the current fiscal year
