MID-OHIO VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL AWARDS

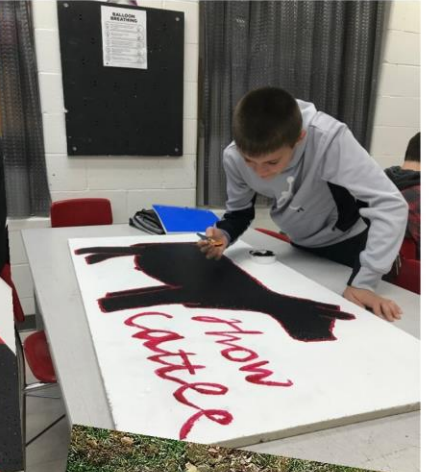
Sawyer Koons was presented the award for the Division VI Mid-Ohio Valley Defensive Player of the Year on Sunday January 12th, 2020.
