Dear Colleagues:

Planning for the 2019 OMEA District 3 Middle School Festival Band/Choir/Jazz has begun. It will once again be held in the Wapakoneta High School Performing Arts Center. The only part of this event that will involve mailing paper is the acceptance fee. Please contact **new** OMEA members in your area to ensure they are on the list serve and don't miss pertinent information. Students **may** participate in the Jazz Band even though they are part of one of the large ensembles as the rehearsals will not overlap.

Before sitting down at a computer to register your students, be sure to have the following documents scanned in PDF format and available for upload. Scan each item separately as they will be uploaded individually for each student. Be prepared to upload the following:

- Copy of your current OMEA card (which does not expire before the event occurs)
- Copy of each student's Emergency Medical Form
- Copy of each student's Transportation Form
- Copy of each student's Image Release Form
- Jazz Band only MP3 recording for those that are auditioning

Directors will not be able to finish the registration process if any of these are not uploaded.

Parent acknowledgment forms **do not** need to be uploaded but should be returned to you to confirm student availability and shirt size. Please do not guess on shirt size (Bubba is going to look funny in a "small" shirt with an exposed midriff. Visualize that one ③). Part of the form references booster contributions. It would be beneficial to speak with your boosters about supporting the festival in advance. This will allow for accurate information on that part of the form. We are asking each booster organization to contribute *something* to the event this year; even if it is at the lowest level. The varying levels of support are available on the booster form below. These donations go a long way in keeping our district events in the black and allow us to offer these experiences for your students. Obviously, this will be up to the organizations but your consideration is appreciated. Thank you in advance.

The web based form can be found through the JH Fest link on our D3 web page. Important dates and deadlines are as follows:

- Nominations begin: Monday, December 10, 2018 (Band: 4 students max, Choir: 6 Students max.)
- Online forms close: January 11, 2019 at midnight
- Results posted on the web: by Midnight January 15th (hopefully sooner).
 - There is a separate nomination form for each organization (band choir, jazz).
- Acceptance Fees: \$25 per accepted student per organization
 - o Postmarked no later than midnight February 1st.
 - o If a student is in two groups, you would deduct the cost of the second shirt. (e.g., a student in the jazz band and concert band would submit \$45).

- o It will be at the discretion of the event chair to allow participation if this fee deadline is missed.
 - Now would be a good time to get PO's in place.

 - o Saturday, March 2, 2019, at Wapakoneta High School, 10:00-noon, 1pm-2:30

 - o Uniform for the concert consists of Khaki pants and the event t-shirt
 - o Choir members will need to bring a black folder for the performance

 - o Sectional director's meals are covered. All other directors may eat at a cost of \$5

Students must be present for all rehearsals and the performance in their entirety. *Students missing any portion of the rehearsals will not be permitted to perform.* Directors, please be certain that students can commit to this schedule before nominating them otherwise they have kept another student from participating. The selection committee will do its best to accept every school's top two students but instrumentation and voice concerns will take precedence over your nomination order. Students must be in seventh or eighth grade in order to participate. Acceptance fees should be mailed to:

Director Letter Addendum Items to consider going forward

- 1. There were a few issues last year with students not being ready for the experience. We are counting on you as a director to only submit students who are sufficiently proficient on their instrument. Nominated students should have a reasonably characteristic tone quality, presentable intonation (especially on the color instruments), and be technically and rhythmically proficient. Please keep these items in mind when nominating students.
- 2. Every year the festival chairs have directors that say the individual responsible for cutting checks for your school district is out sick, slow to pay bills, only cut checks once a month, etc. . We all know the tendencies of our BOE personnel. We also know the maximum amount this event could cost your program. Since that is the case, it would be prudent to get a PO in place *now* so that when the final numbers are released the turnaround time on acceptance fees should be short. Please get ahead of the curve if this is a typical problem with your treasurer. It will save you and the event chairs hassles in the long run.

Thank you for your interest in the 2019 Junior High Honors Jazz Band. Jazz is a genre that is fundamental to a lot of the popular music we listen to today and Charlie Doepker and I are excited to share it with young band students. Often time's directors do not nominate students because there is not a jazz program in their school. Don't let this deter you from nominating students. Many members of previous bands did not have a junior high jazz group at their home school. Since we focus on developing the basics of jazz style, articulation, and improvisation, being deficient in these areas is not an issue.

Before nominating students, be sure they can commit to the following dates/times and have transportation to the site.

Your recordings will need to be in MP3 or WAVE format in order to upload in the nomination form. Please label your recording with your student's name, school and instrument. All audition applications and recordings must be submitted (online) by Friday, January 11, 2019. Audition results will be posted on the event website by Wednesday, January 15, 2019.

You may submit applications (and recordings) for more than one instrument. Alto saxophone players should consider submitting an audition for tenor/and or Bari. Sax. Please encourage bass guitar, guitar and piano players to audition. Check with choir directors for students who may not be in band.
