KINDERGARTEN

Play Dough (Recipe below)

Note: Be sure container can be opened and closed by your child.

Bookbag

Note: Be sure bookbag is easy to open/close and fits over winter coat.

- 1 - Large box of tissues
- 1 - Boys - Container of disinfectant wipes (such as Clorox wipes)
- 1 - Girls - Container of baby wipes
- 1 - Box gallon size Ziploc freezer bags (sliders preferred)
- 1 - Box quart size Ziploc freezer bags (sliders preferred)
- 1 - Set of headphones for computer use - with name on (no earbuds)
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) in a small gym bag
- Small glue rag

PLAY DOUGH RECIPE

- $\frac{3}{4}$ Cup Salt
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cups Flour
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cups Water (add food coloring to water)
- 1 Tablespoon Cream of Tarter
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Tablespoons Cooking Oil

Mix together in a skillet and cook over low heat, stirring constantly. Keep stirring until the mixture cleans the side of the pan. Do Not Undercook. Remove from heat, beat and then cool. Knead until pliable. Add flour if sticky or reheat until it is not sticky to touch. Put in a plastic bag and keep it soft in a large plastic container. (A medium size margarine tub or Cool Whip tub will fit inside child's desk.)

FIRST GRADE

- 1 - Box of Ziploc freezer bags (girls bring quart size, boys bring gallon size)
- 2 - Pocket folders (with bottom pockets) plastic coated are best, replace as needed.
- 1 - Large box of tissues
- 24 - Sharpened #2 pencils, replace as needed. (Please mark name on pencils.)
- Small rag for glue
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) in a small gym bag

A HEALTHY snack in a small container labeled with your child’s name. (Example: Pretzels, Cheez-its, Goldfish, Crackers. This is for morning snack and must be healthy.)

- 1 - Red pen or pencil

- Bring crackers for snack (similar to last year)
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) in a small gym bag

THIRD GRADE

- 1 - 8" x 5" or larger plastic supply box
- 1 - Set of headphones for computer use – with name on
- 1 - Pair of "Fiskar" scissors (sharp end)
- 8 - #2 pencils (replace as needed during the year)
- 1 - Large eraser & several pencil top erasers
- 1 - Elmer's glue 4 oz.
- 2 - Jumbo glue sticks
- Mechanical pencils (optional)
- 1 - Container of disinfectant wipes (boys only)
- 1 - Container of baby wipes (girls only)
- 2 - Boxes of 24 crayons (Regular or Twist Up)
- 1 - Wide-ruled, single subject notebook
- 2 - Boxes of "Ziploc" bags (1 quart & 1 gallon)
- 4 - Pocket folders (bottom pocket, no side pockets)
- 1 - 12" Ruler with inches and centimeters (wooden if possible)
- 1 - Red pen
- 1 - Yellow highlighter
- 1 - Large box of tissues
- 1 - Box of crackers for snack
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) in a small gym bag

FOURTH GRADE

- 2 - Red pens
- 1 - Sharpie black ultra fine point marker
- 1 - Sharpie black fine point marker
- 3 - Yellow highlighters
- 3 - Spiral wide-ruled notebooks
- 1 - Pack of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper (to be placed in folder)
- 4 - Dry erase markers & old wash cloth
- 1 - Bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 - Glue stick
- 1 - Container of disinfectant wipes (such as Clorox wipes)
- 1 - Box of crayons (24 pack)
- 1 - Box of Ziploc freezer bags (girls bring gallon size, boys bring quart size)
- 6 - Pocket folders (with large bottom pockets) plastic coated/vinyl are best
- 2 - Large boxes of tissues
- 12 - Sharpened #2 pencils (write name on pencils)
- 1 - Trapper Keeper
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) & gym clothes in a small gym bag

FIFTH GRADE

- 1 - Pencil pouch - available for \$1.00 during book bill collection days.
 - 1 - Set of headphones for computer use
 - 1 - Scissors (Fiskar sharp pointed)
 - 2 - Mechanical pencils with replacement leads
 - 1 - Set of colored pencils (12 pack)
 - 2 - Ballpoint pens (1 red, 1 blue or black)
 - 2 - Yellow highlighters
 - 1 - Spiral wide-ruled notebook
 - 1 - Small pack of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
 - 4 - Dry erase markers & old wash cloth (replace as needed)
 - 1 - Glue stick
 - 1 - Container of Clorox disinfectant wipes
 - 2 - Two-pocket folders (plastic coated/vinyl are best)
 - 1 - Large box of tissues
 - 1- 3-ring binder (1½")
 - 1 - Set of dividers (8 tabs with pockets, if possible)
 - 1 - Pack of 3x3 post-it notes
- Gym shoes (not worn outside) & gym clothes in a small gym bag
