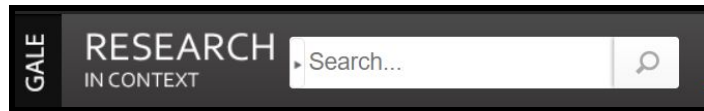
## How to find Britannica School (Middle)

## Browsing Topics

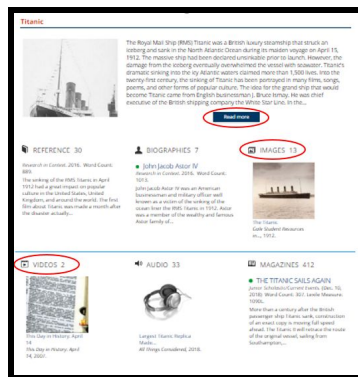


Research in Context does a great job of giving categories if you aren't quite sure what you are looking for.

## Breaking Down a Research in Context Result



There are several types of information available but these will be the most helpful:

“Read More” will give you the informational article about the topic

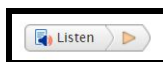
Images will give you photos and pictures about your topics

Videos will give you all available videos about your topic.

## Translate and Read Aloud

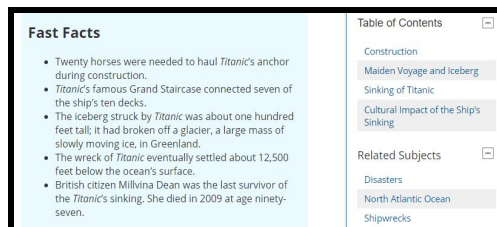


There is a Translate box at the far right in the Tools Box
