Band Fittings?

You wouldn't buy a pair of shoes without trying them on first! Instruments are the same way.

At your fitting, you'll meet one of the Band Directors, actually get to play the instrument you're interested in, receive information on how to acquire an instrument, and MORE!

You're going to get to play the instruments you're interested in to see if it's a good fit for you.

For example, a percussion fitting is extensive because we are looking at your hand-eye coordination, ability to follow directions, ability to maintain a steady tempo, and capability to learn two different instruments at the same time.

Brass and woodwind fittings look for your ability to produce the correct sound, hold the instrument appropriately, and so on.

NOTE: All students interested in <u>Percussion</u> and Saxophone are REQUIRED to come to a fitting.

How to Register for Band:

3. After fittings, we will make sure that your information gets to the JH Guidance office. But, you still need to make sure you fill in the appropriate information on your future band member's scheduling worksheet at school.

Band at Timberstone is a year-long, graded course. Each 6th grade band member will have rehearsal 3 days a week, 4 performances throughout the year, and the chance to participate in several optional performance settings.

This course does require the acquisition of an instrument and method book. We'll have instrument information at the fitting nights. If your family budget doesn't have room for this, please contact a director, we may be able to help you out.
