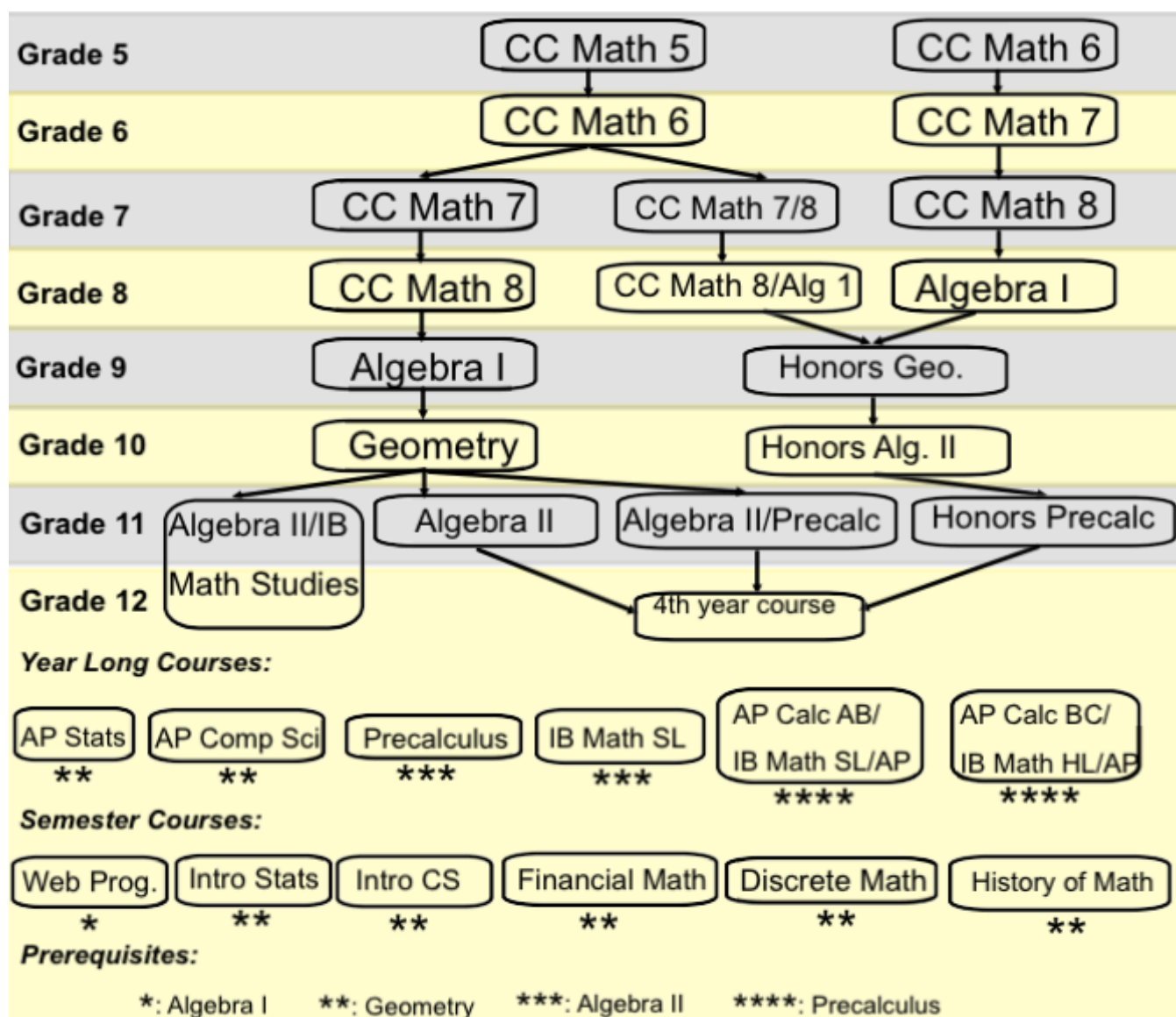


Upper Arlington Mathematics Course Progressions

Important Vocabulary:

Honors: A higher, more challenging level. Topics are explored more deeply and more rigorously with theoretical abstraction and extensions. Success requires a strong work ethic, interest in mathematics, and a high aptitude for mathematics.

Accelerated: Being one year ahead of the “standard” curriculum. Ex: CC Math 8 in 7th grade.

Compacted (or Combined) Course: A course that covers multiple course standards in one year. Each day, CC Math 7/8 and CC Math 8/Alg I require one period. Alg II/Precalc requires two periods.

Plus: Extra remediation built into a student’s schedule that meet 2.5 periods a week that serves as Tier II intervention.

Flex Exams: (*only available at UAHS*). Examinations testing major concepts and standards in each class. Given twice a year (December and June). Must achieve an 80% to gain credit and move to next course. Grade on test is reported on transcript.
