PLCC offers 16 career-based secondary programs housed in the main campus, as well as four satellite programs. PLCC also offers a full slate of academic programs, including an Early College High School program sponsored by the University of Akron.

The Adult Education office offers up to 10 full-time and 3 part-time programs at the main campus, including a new cosmetology program poised to open in the Fall 2018. We offer a full compliment of federal student aid options, including Pell Grants and direct student loans, to help adult students meet their tuition obligations.
