***The Ohio State Tests (sometimes called the AIR Tests)** will occur over a series of late start dates in April and early May. (Late starts are for **HS students only**.) Students take the tests that correspond to their current course enrollments. Some students may have as many as four tests, while others may not have any at all. Students report at 7:35, unless they are not testing that day. If they are not testing, classes begin at 9:35. **Bus transportation will be at the regular time**. We will offer a study hall for students who must arrive at 7:30, but are not testing. An individualized testing schedule has been emailed to each student. We recommend that you ask your student to check their school email account, and review their testing assignments with them. Questions? Ask Asst.
