What is FIRST Lego League Jr?

Children ages 6-9, (Grades 1-3) captures young children's curiosity and directs it towards discovering the wonders of science and technology. This program features a real-world scientific concepts to be explored through research, teamwork, construction, and imagination. Guided by adult coaches, teams use LEGO bricks to build a model that moves and develop a *Show Me Poster* to illustrate their journey.

Children get to:

- ⇒ Design and build a challenge-related model using LEGO We-Do components
- ⇒ Create a Show Me Poster and practice presentation skills
- ⇒ Explore challenges facing today's scientists
- ⇒ Discover real-world math and science
- ⇒ Begin developing teamwork skills
- ⇒ Participate in expos and showcases
- ⇒ Engage in team activities guided by FLL Jr. Core Values
