What is Title 1?

- Title 1 funds are designed to serve at risk and disadvantaged students.
- Title 1 funds are federal dollars that Supplement State and Local Funds, the <u>DO NOT</u> supplant them.
- Funding is based on the building's percentage of low income families.
- Title 1 Services are based on the academic needs of the students
- Sylvania has 4 elementary buildings that run a School Wide Program, which means every student and every staff member is eligible for services

How does a Title 1 building help our students community?

- Provide opportunities to increase student achievement
- Provide instructional supplies and materials
- Provide instructional programs and experiences
- Provide Additional teachers and support staff
- Provide Professional Development
- Provide Parental Engagement Activities

Title 1 Parents Right to Know

As a parent/guardian with a student attending a Sylvania school that receives Title 1 funds, you have the right to know the qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. The federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act requires that any local school district receiving Title 1 funds must provide the following information to parents/guardians who ask about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher:

- Whether the teacher has met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides your child instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or temporary status that waives state licensing requirements.
- The undergraduate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate degree or certification (such as National Board Certification) held by the teacher and the field of discipline or certification or degree.
- Whether your child is provided services by instructional paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
