Oregon City Schools is proud of the hard work our employees do each day. This program honors that work and recognizes the outstanding individuals we have at OCS.

Employee Award Levels

Teachers

- 3 Quarterly Teacher Excellence Awards from elementary
- 3 Quarterly Teacher Excellence Awards from intermediate/junior high combined
- 3 Quarterly Teacher Excellence Awards from high school
- 1 Annual Teacher Excellence Award selected from the nine quarterly winners

Support Staff

- 3 Quarterly Support Staff Excellence Awards each quarter selected from all classifications
- 1 Annual Support Staff Excellence Award selected from the nine quarterly winners

Administration

1 Annual Administrator Excellence Award selected from nominations throughout the year

Awards

Quarterly Awards: \$100 Gift Visa Card, classroom visit, public recognition at BOE meeting, marquee, and individual award plaque.

Annual Awards: \$500 cash award, award announced and presented at May Board meeting, recognized at annual opening day meeting, public recognition (website, facebook, press release, etc.), individual award plaque

Eligibility Requirements:

Employees who have been employed in the Oregon City Schools a minimum of three years are eligible to be nominated for this award.

Nomination Process:

Fellow staff members, students, students' parents/guardians and residents of the district may nominate teachers deserving of this recognition. Nomination forms are available online, at any Oregon School or at the Oregon City Schools' Administration Building.

Please complete the nomination process by filling out the application form and by writing a summary, maximum 500 words, of how your nominee meets the Oregon City Schools Recognition for Excellence Award attributes, which are explained in the following pages.
