AP Chemistry: 3=CHM 151/4 or 5=CHM 151 and CHM 152

AP Language: 3=ENG 111/4 or 5=ENG 111 and ENG 112

AP Literature: 3=ENG 111/4 or 5=ENG 111 and ENG 113 \*neither AP English replaces ENG 231/ENG 232/ENG 241 or ENG 242. Students will have to take at least two of these to complete AA/AS.

AP Psychology: 3=PSY 150

AP Statistics: 3=MAT 152

AP US History: 3=HIS 131 or HIS 132/4 or 5=HIS 131 and HIS 132

AP World History: 3=HIS 111

(NOTE: No High School credit is awarded for ACA 122 because it is a one-hour course, but it is required for AA/AS)
