

STREAM and DRAMA CAMP BEHAVIOR POLICY

Stark County Catholic Elementary Schools (Holy Cross) follows the policy guidelines set forth by the Diocese of Youngstown's Student Code of Conduct. This code states that our programs have a special responsibility for the conduct of children and for ensuring the rights of leaders to interact with children in a safe and caring Christian environment.

We would like your camper to have the best experience possible during the Summer STREAM Express and Drama Camps. Thus, all participants must understand and follow these guidelines and rules.

These rules and expectations are in place to ensure the safety of your child and staff:

Listen to staff.

Be respectful to staff and other campers.

Respect property at the camp and during field trips.

Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

Participate in STREAM camp activities.

Use an inside voice when indoors.

Follow staff instructions.

Clean up after yourself.

Be helpful to others.

Guidelines when rules and expectations are not followed:

Step 1: Verbal warning

Step 2: Time out from the activity (age – appropriate)

Step 3: Behavior communicated to parent

Step 4: Conference with parent to form an action plan

Step 5: Meeting with the supervisor, necessary staff, and parents

In the event that a camper engages in behavior which poses a threat of bodily harm to him/herself, others, or property, the child will be removed from the activity and meeting will be held with the parents/guardians. Continued behavior infractions may result in a child not being permitted to continue in the camp.

The staff will review these rules with campers at the beginning of each week. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
