INCIDENT DETAILS

2. Two students had an altercation after a basketball game. Both students accused each other of spreading rumors. One student was given OSS, and the other student was given ISR and a suspension from one extracurricular activity.
3. A student reported that two other students were picking on him during 7th period. A teacher spoke to the students, and the student's schedule was changed to avoid further contact with the other two students.
4. A student had been picking on the other student on the bus. The student's brother intervened and another student punched his brother. Charges were pressed against the student from the parents of the victim. OSS for the student who hit the other student. Parents for all students were called, and conferences were held with all students involved.

Incident Detail

1. A student continually physically harassed students throughout the school setting. Prior to this incident, meetings were held, supports were provided, out of school suspensions were assigned and then ultimately the child was placed on home instruction for an extended period of time.
2. Three students chose to verbally harass a child in their class due to the clothes this child was wearing. The students were assigned ISR for this infraction and parents were also contacted by the principal.
3. A student reported bullying to our guidance counselor. After student meetings were conducted, parents were notified and interventions were put in place, the child bullying the other child ended up in ISR and we changed student schedule as a result to avoid further interaction.
