Incident Detail

1. A student repeatedly sought out other students to either verbally or physically harass them in the school setting and on the bus as well. This student was given warnings, parent meetings were held, detention, alternate transportation was arranged, ISR and OSS were served. In the midst, an alternate daily schedule was created as well. Once options were exhausted Home Instruction was put into place.
2. A student repeatedly used inappropriate language and remarks towards students. This student also physically harassed students in the classroom. This student was given warnings, parent phone conferences were held, detention, ISR and OSS were served.
3. A student was found to have participated in cyber bullying another student on campus. This student had a conference with the Principal, Resource Officer and Parent to address the situation. OSS was served.
4. A student repeatedly sought out students to verbally or physically harass in the classroom and on the school bus. The student was given warnings, parent meetings were held on the phone and at the guardians home. The student was assigned detention, ISR, and OSS.

Incident Detail

1. 2 Female students harassed and threatened one female student via social media and in the hallways at school. Parents were called and meetings were held to stop the behavior. One of the girls did not heed to the warnings and physically harmed the same female student that she was told to stay away from. This involved ISR and one student being expelled for the remainder of the semester.
2. 3 male students were caught asking a special needs student to say comments that he did not understand and then videotaping it. Parent phone calls to parents were made and suspensions were handed out.
3. 1 male student was verbally harassed by another student using inappropriate racial comments that resulted in a physical altercation in the men's locker room. An investigation was conducted and parents of all parties were notified and the result was suspension from participation in extracurricular activities.
4. 2 male students repeatedly physically harassed another student in the men's locker room which resulted in a physical altercation. An investigation was conducted and parents of all parties were notified and the result was suspensions from participation in extracurricular activities.
