What is career exploration?

A program available for juniors and seniors to explore careers with practicing professionals. Qualifying students who successfully complete all program requirements and school responsibilities will earn ¼ credit hour toward graduation.

Program Requirements

- COMMIT to the successful completion of the program
- Spend a total of 16 hours with the employer at his/her workplace
- Arrange transportation to and from the work site
- Keep a log of time and activity for each visit
- Maintain a journal, recording events, feelings, and learning experiences
- Be responsible for following directions and complete assigned tasks
- Prepare and present a final product or presentation demonstrating learned knowledge
- Write a thank you letter to employer
- Complete a self-evaluation upon completion of the program
