Update on Attendance and Truancy in Ohio, and for Wapakoneta Virtual



- HB 410 was passed in Ohio recently and mandates regular, continuous attendance in school for all compulsory school aged children.
- We all know how important it is to attend school on a daily basis. At Wapakoneta this means logging into Schoology/Compass, completing lessons and quizzes, attending tutoring as required and logging attendance EVERY DAY!
- If a student is habitually truant or has excessive absences
 Wapakoneta, and every other public school in Ohio, is mandated by
 law to report that student to the juvenile courts. In addition, any
 student who is aged 15-18 will also be reported to the Department of
 Motor Vehicles and the student's permit or license will be suspended.
