Many scholarships NEED information from the FAFSA—it must get done today if you have not. The FAFSA is your gateway to financial aid, student loans, college work/study programs and federal grants. You use your 2017 tax information, and you can do it online.

*AAA Auto Club has a School Safety Patrol scholarship available. Applications are available in the Guidance Office and are due by **Friday**, **February 22**, **2019**. If you have been on safety patrol during your elementary years, this one might be for you.

Abbott and Fenner has a scholarship available online at www.abbottandfenner.com/scholarships.htm The deadline to apply for this scholarship is **June 14, 2019.**

- ***AES** is for those pursuing degrees in civil engineering, surveying or a related field. Deadline to apply is **March 29**, **2019**. This company is located in Celina, Ohio.
- *If your family uses **AMP** as their utilities provider, apply for their scholarship online. The deadline to apply is **February 15, 2019**.
