

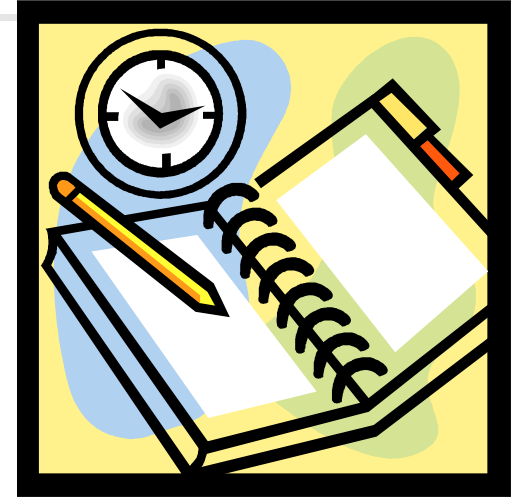

# Special Awards

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## Academic Honors Diploma:

**Must meet all but one:**

- 4 credits of Math
- 4 credits of Science (must include Bio, Chem. and advanced)
- 4 credits of Social Studies
- 3 credits of a language or 2 credits of two different languages
- 1 credit of Fine Arts
- 27 or higher ACT composite, or 1210 SAT total
- 3.5 GPA or higher

- Check with college about credit
- 14 courses...Some singletons
- .05 if A or B internal add-on
- 5.0 weighted GPA
- Rigorous Courses!

# PE Waiver

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- Waiver does NOT grant credit, only waives PE requirement
- Must complete 2 FULL seasons of a sport, 2 years of Marching Band, OR 2 years of JROTC.
- Cannot mix and match
- Must complete 80% of the season

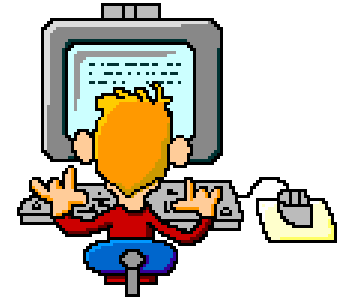

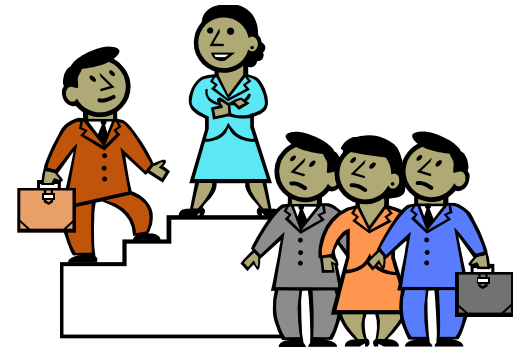
