### White Bluff Elementary School Pre-K Applications

White Bluff Elementary School Office, March 11-15 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., for children four years old by August 15, 2019, who are zoned for White Bluff Elementary School.

What to bring: (All documentation must be turned in to be considered for the class)

- Birth Certificate
- Evidence of Immunization (see below)
- 3 Proofs of Residence (proof of home ownership, rental agreement, driver license, voter registration card, current utility, telephone, cable bills, etc.)
- Recent complete physical examination noted on state immunization form (by school entrance date). If Tier 1: copy of most recent 1040 or 1040A or verification letter from Dept. of Human Services
- Immunizations needed on state form:
  - Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTaP, or DT if appropriate)
  - Poliomyelitis (IPV or OPV)
  - Measles, Mumps, Rubella (1 dose each, usually given together as MMR)
  - Haemophilus influenza type B (Hib)
  - Hepatitis B (HBV)
  - Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV)
  - Hepatitis A- 1 dose

### OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parents will complete Free/Reduced Lunch Forms the first week of Pre-K. Applications for the Voluntary Pre-K Program are accepted all year long. Please apply even if it is after this application week.

Dickson County Voluntary Pre-K Program Tier Classifications

Tier 1: (Given first consideration)

-Family meets income eligibility guidelines (TCA 49-6-101-110) (Required for proof: Parent 1040A/1040 or DHS Program Participation benefit letter for Food Stamps, Families First, etc.)

-Children of parents fatally wounded in active military duty

Tier 2:

-Children identified with disabilities with a current IEP (Provide a copy of the front page of the IEP)

-Children identified as English Language Learners

Tier 3:

-Children living in a single parent home -Children whose parents are military deployed into active duty

-Children of a disabled veteran (50% disabled or more) - Children of teen parents

-Children of parents with limited education -Children in temporary, permanent, or long-term care of family or guardian

Tier 4:

- Eligible four-year-old children zoned to WBES
