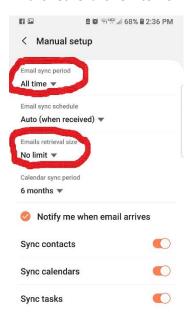
Once connected you should see a screen similar to this:

On the next screen you can customize the account name (leave what's there if you want) or re-name it to something else. i.e. DCBE Work Email



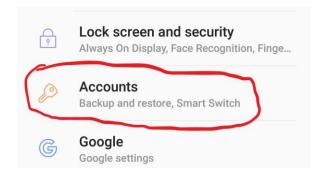

Type in your DCBE Email address, then click Manual set up.

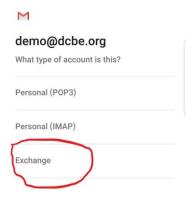


Type in your password and then click next





Choose Exchange:



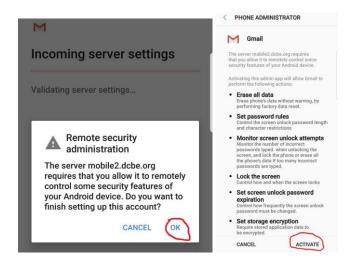
For the server, change it to: mobile1.dcbe.org
