- Differentiate instruction to meet the needs of diverse learners and support individual student success.
- Assess student progress using a variety of formative and summative assessment methods and maintain accurate records of student performance.
- Integrate technology and real-world applications into classroom instruction.
- Maintain a safe, organized, and effective classroom and laboratory environment, including food preparation, food safety, and instructional equipment.
- Enforce safety, sanitation, and health regulations related to food preparation, equipment use, and classroom activities. Ensure that safety procedures and protocols are enforced.
