SOME SPORT HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2017-2018

Female Athlete of the Year

Breanna Brammer, sophomore, participated in volleyball, basketball, and track and field.

As a sophomore, Breanna ended the season at the regional meet, on the podium, in sixth place, for the discus. Breanna improved so much this season that she earned all -Ohio status in the shot put. Breanna advanced to state competition. Making the finals in the shot put, eventually finishing **seventh** in Division III. The performance gave her a spot on the

podium. Breanna also won a regional title in the shot put, in the Region 11 track meet. Breanna established herself as one of the best throwers in the Southeast District, and she should continue to compete for spots in the state track and field meet the next two seasons.

In Football

The Trimble Tomcats had another successful football campaign in the 2017-2018 football season. The season ultimately ended in the Division VII, Region 27 semifinals to eventual regional champion Danville. Max Hooper, Cameron Roback, Ian Joyce, Colton Wright, Sam Ives, and Sawyer Koons were all-league players in 2017. QB Cameron Kittle and Hooper, a running back, were both third team all-Ohio in Division VII, while lineman Anthony McLaughlin was a third team all-Ohio defensive selection.

Volley Season

The volleyball season saw the Tomcats Taya Beth Lackey and Sydney Hardy earn all-Tri-Valley Conference Hocking Division honors. Trimble finished the season with a 10-13 season record, including 8-8 in the TVC Hocking.

Tomcat Golf

The Tomcats golf team was led by senior Nathan Riley, who was an all-league pick. Trimble was 5-35 inside the TVC-Hocking on the golf course .

The Tomcats were able to claim a TVC-Hocking title in boys cross country, backing that up with a district title. Tyler Hudson, Eric Everett, Braydon Weber, Dillon Banik, Danuel Persinger, Zayne Moore and Andrew Monroe were members of the winning boys cross country teams

Boys Cross Country

Trimble was able to win another TVC-Hocking title in boys basketball, its third in four years. The Tomcats went 18-6 on the season, including 13-3 for the outright TVC-Hocking crown. Randy Hixon was the TVC-Hocking Most Valuable Player, and Howie Caldwell won the TVC-Hocking Coach of the Year award. Trimble was also able to win a sectional title for the fifth year in a row to advance to Ohio University's Convocation Center. Max Hooper, Cameron Kittle and Brayden Weber joined Hixon on the all-league team.

Girls Basketball

The Tomcats suffered a tough blow during girls basketball season when the campaign was cut short due to lack of players. Trimble started the season with only seven players and injuries ultimately forced the school to make the tough decision. Before the season ended Trimble did gain a 40-37 win at Southern on Dec. 11th, 2017. Sydney Hardy had 16 points and Kaitlyn Spears scored 12 points in the comeback win. It was the highlight of the season for Trimble. The Tomcats had three underclassmen on the roster, juniors- Skylar Moore and Sidney Moore and sophomore Breanna Brammer.

Wrestling Season

In wrestling the Tomcats were able to boast two TVC champions in Todd Fouts and Ian Joyce. Fouts won the league title at 126 pounds, while Joyce Won at 195 pounds. Their efforts helped Trimble place eighth out of 13 teams in the TVC wrestling championships.

Baseball

The Tomcats were able to return to the district tournament in baseball. It was a successful season, which went 13-9 overall and 9-7 in the TVC-Hocking. Max Hooper, Noah Rossitter, Cameron Kittle and Tyler Roback were all-league selections after the conclusion of the season.

Softball

On the softball diamond, Trimble went 8-11 overall, and 6-2 in the TVC-Hocking. Rhian Brown, Skylar Moore and Taya Beth Lackey were all-league picks.

Brianna Lunsford patrolled the pitching circle all season and Alyssa Turley graduated with 20 career home runs. The Tomcats were able to beat Miller to advance to a Division IV sectional final. Going for a fourth sectional title in a row, the Tomcats lost at Symmes Valley.

Trimble's Track Team

Trimble's boys 4x200 team of Sam Ives, Reece Mohler, Zayne Moore and Dillon Banik were TVC -Hocking Champions, with a time of 1:38.87.

Trimble's 4x800 team of Eric Everett, Danuel Persinger, Dillon Banik and Tyler Hudson finished 12th in Division III, Region 11.

Male Athlete of the Year for Trimble is Randy Hixson, senior basketball. Hixson averaged 26.4 points per game his senior season, scoring 633 points. He finished his career with 1,390 points. Hixson has signed with Division II Ohio Valley University. Large article in May 2018

The Superintendent

Scott Christman, superintendent of Trimble Local Schools, has submitted a letter of resignation to the Trimble Board of Education. According to the district treasurer, Jared Bunting, Christman submitted his letter of resignation at a Board meeting earlier in May 2018.

Bunting said Christman plans to move forward as superintendent of Southern Local Schools, replacing the current superintendent there, Greg Holbert (retiring). Christman previously served as principal at Miller High School in the Southern Local School District.

Mr. Christman has been Trimble's superintendent since August 2014. He had previously worked for the Trimble district as a teacher.

According to Bunting, Christman's last day will be July 31, 2018 which is the end of the contract year for Christman.

Christman has also helped organize efforts to build a new football stadium. The Trimble Athletic Complex Improvement Fund has raised more than \$500,000 toward the new stadium. We here at Trimble appreciate all that Mr. Scott Christman has done for us, and wish him the best of luck with his new position.
