Books are paid for through the use of Federal Title I Grant funds!


From Golden Coin to Book Prize

Parent Teacher Conference Tips

Please be on the lookout for information about upcoming parent teacher conferences. Teachers will reach out to schedule this important time. Here are some tips to make the most of this valuable time with your child's teacher from the Compass Learning Parent Workshop book.

- Make notes before the conference to remind yourself of things you want to discuss. Make notes during the conference so you can review plans and information afterwards.
- 2. Talk with your child's teacher about goals.
- 3. Tell your child's teacher about problems at home that may be affecting your child's classroom behavior or work. This insight will help the teacher support and assist your child.
- 4. Share positive comments as well as concerns. If your child came home all excited about something he or she did in class, let the teacher know!
- 5. Each conference is scheduled for 15 minutes so teachers can meet with all parents. Your child will do their best to start and end your conference on time. It is helpful to choose two or three items you want to make sure get covered. If you feel that you have further questions, please feel free to make a future appointment with the teacher.
