



SCS SCHOOLS RANKED IN U.S. NEWS AND WORLD REPORT

U.S. News & World Report has released its latest rankings for educational success and Steubenville City Schools once again has made the list. According to the publication, all four elementary buildings, including East Garfield, McKinley STEM Academy, Pugliese West and Wells Academy, as well as Harding Middle School were named among the 2025 Best Elementary Schools and Best Middle Schools because they placed among the top 40 percent in Ohio. A total of 59,128 private, public K-8 and public high schools were reviewed among the rankings and each of the Steubenville schools is eligible to display a trademarked Best Elementary Schools or Best Middle Schools award badge logo to celebrate their designation.





"We are incredibly proud of the recognition our schools have received from U.S. News & World Report as some of the top-performing schools in Ohio. This achievement reflects the dedication and hard work of our students, teachers, staff, and families across the district. STEUBENVILLE SCHOOLS GAIN OVERALL 5-STAR RATING

The Steubenville City School District and three of its buildings have achieved overall 5-star ratings for their performance from state education officials. The Ohio Department of Education and Workforce recently recognized exceptional performances in Ohio's districts and buildings on 2022-2023 Report Card, and the Steubenville City School District is one of 75 districts across the state to be recognized as an overall 5-Star district. 
