






If you answered no to the above question, are you interested in a 100% online option sponsored by Dover City Schools for the 2020-2021 school year? (1,119 responses)




If necessary to offer school on a half-day basis (either morning or afternoon) in order to maintain required social distancing, would you send your child to school half-day? (1,320 responses)




