It was noted that Bayshore Counseling and Firelands have been quite helpful during this transition.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMITTEE CHAIR REPORT.

Nancy Martin, Planning Committee Chair was not present. Diane gave the report. Discussion was about the status of ECHD crisis center and their capacity challenges. Director from SSOW, Huron Counties to discuss expansion.

FINANCE COMMITTEE.

Rob Quinn, Finance Committee Chair was not present. Thomas Tucker gave the report. He explained there was discussion regarding the carpet replacement, CY2025 Budget Revisions, SOS 4.0, and the Kaptur-Rogowski House.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

PILOT PROGRAM: SERVING OUR SENIORS GUARDIANSHIP

Currently we budget guardianship with Catholic Charities. They have changed their processes/protocols and have chosen not to be guardian of finance. We reached out to a Cleveland entity and Serving Our Seniors who will be collaborating with us on a pilot program to determine if we should move forward with bringing a different guardianship program to Erie County. The Board has allocated \$20k, Serving Our Seniors \$80k, and Probate Court \$10k for possible funding of the Pilot Program. Diane will provide updates as she learns more.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS

At the Blue-Ribbon Commission Meeting, Lisa mentioned a discussion regarding Veteran Justice Outreach. A question was raised about whether Erie County has a Veterans Court that includes PTSD and anger management. Diane informed the Board that data was collected, and the numbers were low. We do have a family court and a drug court, but their numbers are also low. We have worked with veterans through monthly meetings. The Board might also consider implementing a veterans tracking method.

EDUCATIONAL TRAINING SESSION

Eliot Dyer from Erie County Health Department presented the findings from the Annual Assessment Survey, fulfilling the educational requirements of the Board Members.
