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### **Quarter 1 Report Cards**

Keep your eyes peeled for your Quarter 1 report cards, which were finalized on Friday and are being mailed to cyber families this week. Students who are part-time will be given their report cards when on-campus, and all full-time students' report cards are mailed home directly. If you receive your report card and have ANY questions, it is imperative that you reach out to your guidance counselor:

Your guidance counselors work with the building secretaries to finalize your report cards, so please direct any questions you may have about your grades/your child's grades to your counselor. As always, continue to communicate with your teachers at Warren regarding your progress in your classes.

Grades for all classes were pulled on November 3. Anything that was submitted after 11:59 p.m. on November 2 <u>did not get graded</u> and <u>did not count</u> toward your Quarter 1 grade. Be mindful of due dates and deadlines in the Buzz Portal as you continue to progress through your coursework. The next quarter ends on January 19, 2023; all work must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. that evening. The third quarter begins on January 20, 2023.

You've likely noticed that all MS/HS electives are continuous courses that end at the conclusion of the semester, instead of the quarter. Because of this, your grades were still pulled for your electives and all other courses based on the assignments you've completed and grades you earned up through the end of the first quarter (November 2). Any work completed after November 2 at 11:59 p.m. did not count toward your Quarter 1 grade and will, instead, be part of your Quarter 2 grade. This simply means that you continue working on the coursework for your electives just as you do for your core classes based on the deadlines and due dates provided to you by your teachers at Warren; just know that your coursework doesn't "end" for those electives until the end of the semester. Pay attention and adhere to due dates and deadlines in order to keep up with the pace of the course and to avoid falling behind.
