COUNSELOR'S CORNER- SCHEDULING

<u>Scheduling information for current 8th graders</u> – February is an important month for our 8th graders as they start to prepare for their High School classes for next year! Here is the link to the High School Course Selection Guide for your reference Course Guide 2024-2025.pdf

- February 13th 4:30 pm 6:30 pm Department tables set-up in the hallway outside the gym highlighting their courses. Starting at 5:30 pm Scheduling Q&A session (8th grade parents highly encouraged to attend). The High School Counselors will go over graduation requirements, scheduling options for your incoming freshmen and there will be presentations from the various programs discussing their curriculum.
- February 13th 6:30 pm mandatory CCP meeting for any student interested in taking CCP classes next year.
- April 2nd HS counselors meet with all 8th grade students for scheduling presentation
- April 9th the students will input their course requests during their Science classes with the support of the HS Counseling staff.

Once a student inputs their schedule requests, changes must be done through the High School counseling department. Counselors are Khris Scohy (A-G), Andy Hartley (H-O), and Debra Sandeman (P-Z).

Scheduling for current 7th graders and 6th graders -

In addition to Math, Science, English Language Arts, Social Studies our students will have their encore courses and one elective. The school counselors will be meeting with the 6th graders on Feb 27th and 7th graders on Feb 20th to review their scheduling options for next year.
