### GOODWIN AND MALL QUALIFY AS NATIONAL MERIT FINALISTS



Bellbrook High School is pleased to announce that seniors Samantha Goodwin and Nikhil Mall have been named Finalists in the 2023 National Merit Scholarship Program. These talented students will now compete for 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth more than \$31 million.

The selection process for the National Merit Scholarship Program is highly competitive and rigorous. Over 1.5 million juniors from more than 22,000 high schools across the United States took the 2022 Preliminary PSAT/NMSQT exam, which served as the initial screening of program entrants. Only those students who scored the highest in each state were selected as Semifinalists, representing less than 1% of all high school seniors in the country.

The National Merit Scholarship winners will be announced in four nationwide news releases that are scheduled to take place later this spring. As the students move forward as National Merit Scholarship Finalists, Bellbrook High School is proud to recognize and celebrate their accomplishments and wishes them the best of luck as they compete for this prestigious award.

# CLASSROOM AND DEPARTMENTAL NEWS

## COMPUTER SCIENCE

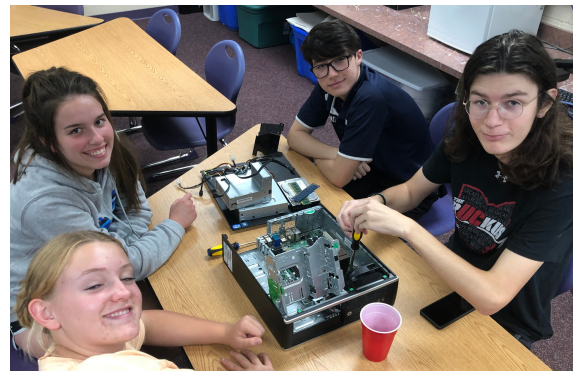
The BHS Computer Science students have begun the 2nd semester by diving deeper into their respective areas of study.

**Intro to Java Programming** students are working on building foundational skills that will be applied in future projects, and future courses. They recently learned the importance of using variables to store data in a program and are currently using those variables to complete calculations using arithmetic operators. In the weeks to come, they will learn to use loops and selection statements to control the flow of a program.

**Game Development and Multimedia Programming** students are writing code using the Python programming language to create music. We started the unit by writing code to mix their own music by selecting from over 2500 pre-created clips and mixing them in creative ways. Students are currently learning to create their own custom beats and will eventually learn to add a variety of effects (echo, static, fade, etc.).

Students in **AP Computer Science A** recently completed the unit on searching and sorting large collections of data and are now learning to read data from saved files. These skills will be applied later in the unit when students will create a Home Inventory System. The **AP Computer Science Principles** students are programming as well. The class is currently working to learn programming skills that will soon be applied to the AP Create Performance Task...a required project that will count as a significant portion of their AP Exam grade. In this course, students are allowed to choose from a variety of offered languages including Java, Python, C++, C#, and App Inventor for their project.

The **Advanced Game Development** students are working on a 1st-person action and adventure game using the Unity game development environment.



# CLASSROOM AND DEPARTMENTAL NEWS

## HEALTH AND PE



The Health and Physical Education Department is in full swing in the 2nd semester and the teachers and students are all looking forward to what this semester has in store. The focus of the Health classes has shifted from exploring the balance of physical, mental/emotional, and social health to create overall wellness to delving into the topic of stress and its impact on the body. Mrs. Rose and Mr. Jenkins have been teaching the students about stress and are exploring various stress management techniques.

In Health classes, students are also developing their health skills through a variety of activities. These skills include accessing valid information, using effective communication skills to enhance health, identifying healthy decision-making skills, advocating for one's health, adopting behaviors that contribute to positive health, and reducing behaviors that are health risks. This hands-on approach to learning is helping the students to better understand the various aspects of health and how they can improve their overall well-being.



The PE classes have also been keeping students active and engaged. In Mind and Body Wellness, students participate in daily yoga, meditation, or Pilates sessions, while in Weightlifting, they are continuing to complete daily workouts in the weight room. PE 2 is playing Team Handball and PE classes will soon be participating in the Fitnessgram Fitness testing. This assessment measures flexibility, muscular strength and endurance, and cardiovascular endurance. The PE classes are also continuing to complete the Ohio Physical Education Standard Assessments.



In Leadership class, the students are continuing to develop their leadership skills and traits. The class is exploring strategies, traits, habits, routines, and commonalities from highly effective leaders through readings, group activities, discussions, and presentations. The focus is on helping the students to develop the skills and traits that they need to be effective leaders in their personal and professional lives.

The Health and Physical Education Department is providing a well-rounded educational experience for the students, helping them to develop their health skills, physical fitness, and leadership abilities.



# CLASSROOM AND DEPARTMENTAL NEWS

## BHS AIR FORCE JROTC

AFJROTC Cadets have been extremely busy since the school year began in August. In addition to their daily classes that include academics, instruction in drill, physical fitness and weekly uniform wear, cadets have already completed over 1,500 service hours this year, with many more to come. In the fall, cadets conducted their annual food drive - they went door to door in neighborhoods in Bellbrook and collected close to 10,000 non-perishable items donated directly to the Bellbrook Sugarcreek Community Resource Center. They presented the colors at over 25 events including football & basketball games, parades, and other events around the Bellbrook area. They manned a hydration station at the AF Marathon. They honored our local veterans at BCI's annual Veterans' Day breakfast with a saber arch, a color guard, and a flag folding presentation. Finally, they hosted a blood drive in February and helped the Community Blood Center collect 36 much-needed pints of blood. Cadets also partner with the Kettering VFW to honor veterans at funerals as part of the VFW Honor Guard.

While community service is a big part of what JROTC cadets do, they also compete with and participate in activities with other JROTC units in the area. In the fall, the JROTC Raiders team competed in a Raiders competition, a physical fitness competition, hosted by Xenia HS AFJROTC.. The Academic Team is currently competing in their on-line academic competition hoping to make it to the National Competition in June. Last year, Bellbrook's AFJROTC academic team was one of the 16 teams that made it to the National competition in Washington DC. Bellbrook cadets also attended a JROTC Military Ball in December and in January, a few cadets attended Beaver Creek JROTC's Combat Dining In.

Coming up in the spring, cadets plan to continue their dedication to community service through many events in the school, the district and the community. Bellbrook JROTC will also be hosting a 14-mile hiking event for local JROTC units and are looking forward to participating in the Sugar Maple Festival parade.

# ABOVE AND BEYOND



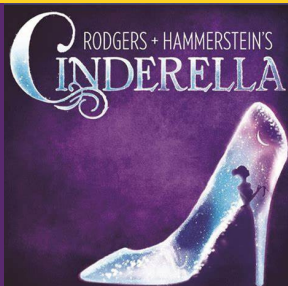
