COUNSELOR'S CORNER

Scheduling information for 8th graders – February is an important month for our 8th graders as they start to prepare for their High School classes for next year!

- <u>February 8th</u>, the High School counselors will be over to speak to our 8th graders about the scheduling process and high school graduation requirements..
- <u>February 15th,</u> starting at 4:30 pm there will be a High School Curriculum night sponsored by the High School Guidance Department. The questions and answers portion with the Counseling Dept. will begin at 5:30-6:00 and the College Credit Plus information meeting will start at 6:30. The High School Counselors will go over graduation requirements, scheduling options for your incoming freshmen, and there will be presentations from the various programs discussing their curriculum. *Correction from last month's letter- this is an in-person event!
- March 5th, the students will input their course requests during their Science classes with the support of the HS Counseling staff.

*Once a student inputs their schedule requests, changes must be done through the High School counseling department. Counselors are Khris Scohy (A-G), Andy Hartley (H-O), and Debra Sandeman (P-Z).

Scheduling for 6th and 7th grade students -

In addition to Math, Science, English Language Arts, and Social Studies our students will have their encore courses and one elective. The school counselors will be meeting with the 6th graders on Feb 26th and 7th graders on Feb 27th to review their scheduling options for next year. Below is the list of ENCORE classes and the elective choices for our 7th and 8th graders.

*If your 6th or 7th grade student is dropping band class for next year, we MUST have parent permission via phone call, email or written note to their counselor.

7th Grade Encore (12 week courses for ALL students):

- Physical Education, Health, Automation and Robotics (STEM)

7th Grade Electives: Band, Choir OR Elective Rotation which includes the three courses below:

8th Grade Encore (12 week courses for ALL students):

- Introduction to Family Consumer Science, Design and Modeling (STEM), Physical Education 8th Grade Electives: Band, Choir, OR Elective Rotation which includes the three courses listed below.
 - Food and Fitness, Medical Detectives (STEM), Digital Literacy
