Scheduling for current 8th Graders

Scheduling information for 8th grade – February is an important month for our 8th graders as they start to prepare for their High School classes for next year!

- February 9th the High School counselors will be over to speak to our 8th graders about the scheduling process and high school requirements..
- February 16th at 5:00 pm There will be a High School Curriculum night sponsored by the High School Guidance Department. The High School Counselors will go over graduation requirements, scheduling options for your incoming freshmen and there will be presentations from the various programs discussing their curriculum. - February 24th the students will input their course requests during their Science classes with the support of the HS Counseling staff.
