Do you have plans for the summer? Looking for something fun to do and to meet some new people all while participating in super fun activities? We may have just what you are looking for to beat the summertime heat!

The Greene County Board is collaborating with day programs throughout the county to provide Summer Transition Programs. Transition aged youth, 14-21, who are interested can attend a summer program of their choice 3 or 5 days/week throughout the summer.

WHO: Any **<u>ELIGIBLE</u> (must have gone through eligibility through GCBDD to participate) AND ages 14-21.</u>**

WHERE: We have **12 options** of summer transition programs providing summertime fun.

Align (Beavercreek), Caterpillars to Butterflies (Huber Heights), Echoing U (Dayton), Equal People (Fairborn), Goodwill (Trotwood location but will be out and about in the community most of the day), Goodworks Farm (Xenia), Greene, Inc. (Xenia), Miss Bee's Hive (Springfield), Orange Lotus (Xenia), Toward Independence, Inc. (Xenia), Unity Care Group (Centerville), and Viaquest (2 locations...Centerville and Dayton)

WHEN: During summer break from school (typically 10 weeks)

- **COST:** No cost for the program. Each individual program may have additional costs for activity fees
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Depends on the program site however, typically the family provides their own transportation to and from the program.
