

Test Taking Strategies

- Get an adequate amount of sleep before the test.
- Eat healthy and stay hydrated.
- Complete practice questions and/or practice tests. This will help you familiarize yourself with the types of test questions as well as lower your overall anxiety.
- Eat a mint while testing.
- Believe in yourself! Believe you will do well!
- Take slow deep breaths and exhale slowly before and during the test.
- Use grounding techniques (e.g. 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 method) if anxiety starts to take over.
