This month you will receive the FAST Family Report that provides information on your child's performance and changes over time on FAST (Formative Assessment System for Teachers) assessments in Reading and Math. The most informative parts of the reports will be the first section on Math and on English, which indicates how your student is performing related to their grade level and the second section with percentile rankings that compare your student to others the same age. The third section has a graph that may not be easy to read because of the way it prints out multiple assessments on one graph. If you have a desire to know more about the reports or any other aspect of FAST Bridge testing, please feel free to contact the school's RTI Manager, Carolyn Hickerson.
