

Dear Ottoville Families,

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) passed a waiver providing schools with funds from the federal government to feed ALL students at no charge for a limited time. The purpose of this federal program is to minimize the challenges of meal service during the pandemic

Beginning Monday, September 21, 2020, ALL OTTOVILLE STUDENTS IN GRADES K-12 WILL RECEIVE A FREE LUNCH EACH DAY THAT SCHOOL IS IN SESSION UNTIL DECEMBER 31ST OR UNTIL USDA FUNDS ARE DEPLETED, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

This does not include Ala Carte items, extra main entrée, and extra milk for lunch or snack.

You are not required to fill out any forms to receive this; however, if you qualify for reduced or free lunches, you must still fill out the application to continue to receive this benefit if you have not already done so.

Money that is currently on students' accounts will remain in accounts until meal charges resume. Once the USDA funds are depleted, all lunchroom fees will resume.
