Mathcounts 2nd in Region

The Timberstone MathCounts Club and Competition Team has been practicing since October. The competition consists of 2 individual rounds and a team round. The Sprint round has 30 questions to be answered in 40 minutes without the use of a calculator. The Target round has 4 pairs of questions that each set has to be answered in 6 minutes with the use of a calculator. The Team round has 4 students that together have to answer 10 questions in 20 minutes with the use of a calculator.

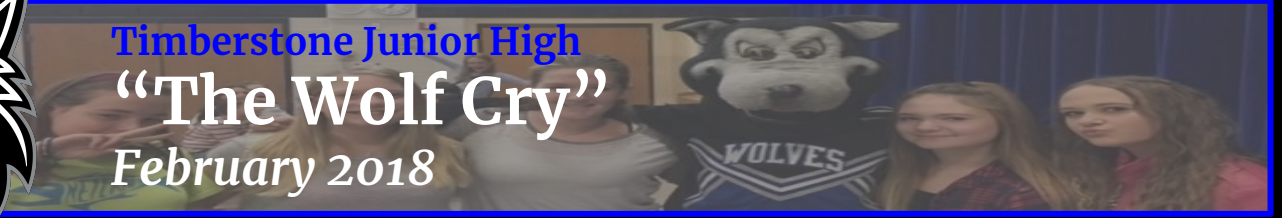
The first week back in January the students competed for a position on the Competition Team. The members of the competition team are: 6th grader Kevin Chou, 7th graders Stefan Chirica, Lauren Jin and Grace Perry; 8th graders Duncan Adkins, Jasjeev Singh, Peter Sung and Andrew Zheng. The Regional MathCounts competition was held on Saturday January 27th at UT's College of Engineering. There were 19 teams that competed from around the Northwest Ohio Area that produced 142 student competitors. Our Timberstone MathCounts team placed 2nd overall in the competition! Way to go MathCounts Wolves! The four-person team of Kevin Chou, Andrew Zheng, Stefan Chirica and Jasjeev Singh qualified to go to the State Competition in Columbus on Saturday March 10th.

Individually, all the students did a great job. Sixth grader Kevin Chou was the highest place who earned 7th out of 142 competitors. Kevin also placed 3rd in the 16 top scorers Countdown round. Way to go Kevin! Eighth grader Andrew Zheng was our 2nd highest scorer, placing 10th out of 142 competitors and he also qualified for participating in the Countdown round. Way to go Andrew! Also placing in the top 25% of the competitors was seventh grader Grace Perry. Fabulous job Grace!

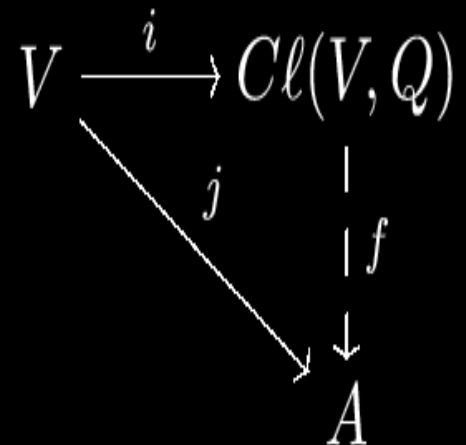
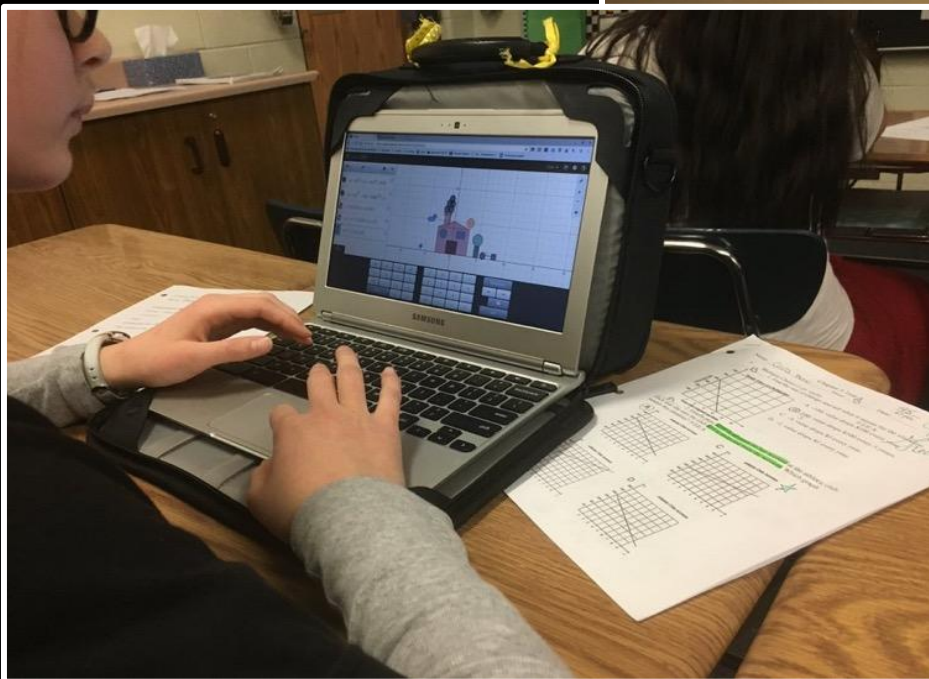
By plugging in algorithmic formulas, Mrs. Brenner's Algebra class created homes using a program called Desmos.

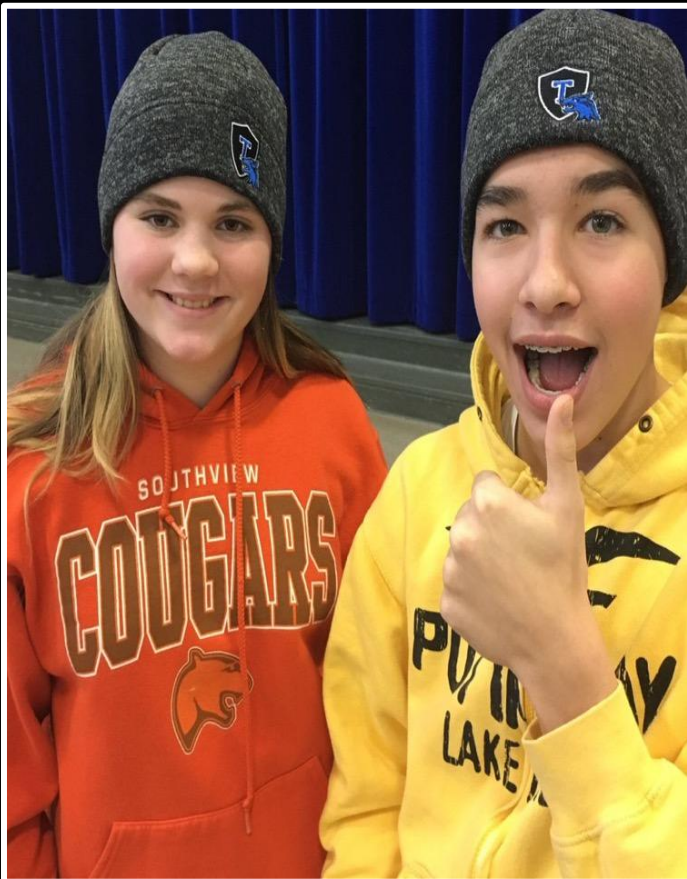

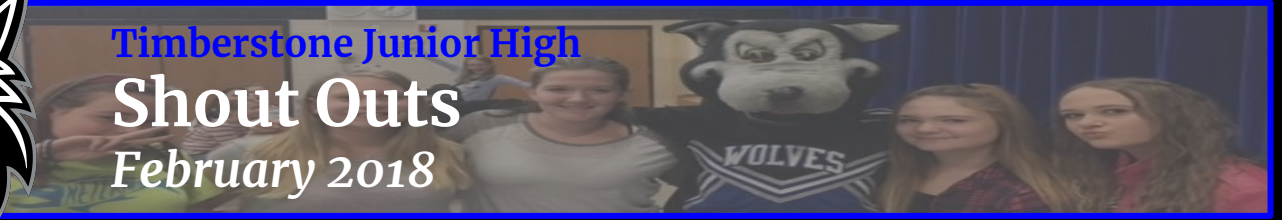

8TH GRADE PLACEMENT AUDITIONS

Scheduling is just around the corner! All 8th grade band members will be assigned a "Playing Test" in google classroom next month. This will be counted as a playing test in their 3rd quarter grade. This audition will be used to place students in the appropriate level of band in high school.

In addition, all band members will be expected to turn in a signed commitment form. The commitment form is a signed confirmation that your musician will or will not be participating in band next year, at Southview High School. The commitment packet will contain information about band in high school, specifically at Southview.

Whether continuing on next year (and we hope all of you do) or not, everybody is required to turn in a commitment form and completing a placement audition.

FAQ's

Do I have to do marching band at Southview? Yes. The High School band course in Sylvania Schools includes concert and marching season. BUT, most of our kids think that marching season is the most fun.

I'm not doing band at SV, why do I have to do this?

Everybody turns in a commitment form and audition so we can adequately assess student performance and have a good idea of who will be doing band next year.

Scroll through the past 12 months and you'll see a good example of what goes on. You can also view the Southview Band Handbook on the web.

Is there Honors Credit for band? Yes! Students wishing to take band for honors credit are enrolled in Symphonic Band and then agree to complete some additional, independent work. This includes a requirement for private study. The goal of the honors credit option is to further increase musical independence.

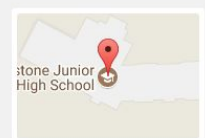
