Students Learn About Legal Profession

The student-led SHOUT organization arranged for legal professionals to come to campus to discuss their work and advise students who are interested in pursuing careers in the field of law. On Thursday, February 20, the group welcomed judges Nicola Henry Taylor and Simquita Bridges along with attorneys Blaine Jones and Frank Walker. The panel discussion was moderated by students **Malak Sayed** and **Madisyn Jones**.

The pros discussed how they got started in law, challenges in the field, and the legacy they hope to leave. They also talked about the importance of representation in the field including gender, race, and even as focused as how many judges are former prosecutors or defenders. Students were inspired to ask questions and seek advice both as part of the group discussion and in personalized conversations after the panel.

In addition to wanting to spread knowledge about law careers, SHOUT organized the event in recognition of Black History Month.
