

Rescheduling PSSAs



As a result of the unexpected school closures this week, the PSSA testing that was to occur has been rescheduled as follows:

- Monday, May 5; Grades 4 8: 2nd section of Math testing (morning only)
- Tuesday, May 6; Grade 5: Science testing 1st section in the morning and 2nd session in the afternoon
- Wednesday, May 7
 - Grade 3: 2nd section of Math testing (morning only)
 - Grade 8: Science testing 1st section in the morning and 2nd session in the afternoon

Students should be sure to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast prior to testing.

Please note that, as a result of changes to the PSSA schedule, Pre-Algebra screenings originally scheduled for Monday and Tuesday will be rescheduled for a later date.



Youth Volleyball Camp


