Michael Carr attended South Fayette from the age of five until graduation in 2016. Growing up, wrestling was a large part of his life, as all of his younger siblings participated in the sport. Their abilities and love towards the sport made him want to follow in their footsteps. Michael wrestled for South Fayette High School from 2013- 2016. He was a 3 time WPIAL champion (2014-2016; 132, 138, and 145) and a 3 time SW Regional champion (2014-2016; 132, 138, and 145). Michael accomplished the highest goal set for himself during his final two seasons when he won two PIAA State titles (2015 and 2016; 138 and 145). With the support of family, friends, and coaches, he earned a scholarship to The University of Illinois. In 2018, he was the Big Ten Runner Up (141 lbs.) and a 2018 NCAA Wrestling Qualifier - Round of 12. In 2019, he was the 141 pound starter and undefeated during the Big Ten Dual season and qualified for the NCAA - Round of 16.

Michael also excelled in the classroom where he was a 2018 NWCA All Academic, 2019 Academic All-Big Ten, 2020 Academic All-Big Ten, and 2021 Academic All-Big Ten. He pursued a Bachelors of Science Degree in Chemistry (2019), Masters of Engineering in Bioengineering (2020), and lastly a Masters of Science in Nuclear, Plasma, and Radiological Engineering (2021). In 2022, Michael enrolled in the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine to pursue his passion for medicine and surgery.
