SF Esports Expands to Include a Unified Team

Esports is growing at South Fayette! In addition to teams in the Middle and High schools, the district recently began competing in a Unified Esports league.

The Fox Chapel Area School District was awarded a \$35,000 Moonshot Grant from The Grable Foundation and the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation, as well as an additional grant from PlayVRS for equipment and gaming codes. They invited South Fayette, along with Pittsburgh Public, Freeport Area, and Beaver Area school districts to team with them on an after-school Unified Esports league. The league is the first of its kind in



Pennsylvania, and only the second one in the nation. Participants in grades 6 - 12 compete in Mario Kart and Super Smash Bros.

Describing the Unified Esports league, Dr. Megan Collett, the executive director of instructional and innovative leadership in the Fox Chapel Area School District, said that it emphasizes that “all students, regardless of ability or neurodiversity, bring unique skills to the table – or in this case, to the screen. It moves beyond ‘inclusion’ to ‘equity,’ where all participants are equally valued and contribute to the team’s success.”

She added, “Rather than utilizing conventional means, it uses gaming technology to foster teamwork, problem-solving, and empathy in a way that feels relevant and exciting to today’s learners. It also disrupts conventional approaches by integrating students from diverse geographic, socioeconomic, and ability backgrounds, ensuring that every student has access to the same opportunities and tools.”

South Fayette’s two Unified Esports teams kicked off their season on Wednesday playing Mario Kart online against teams from East Noble HS in Indiana and Plano HS in Illinois.

Senior Sparks National Spotlight



Senior **Nandana Menon** was recognized on a national level this week when she won the SXSW EDU Student Impact Challenge after pitching her app called Spark at their event in Austin, TX.

As described on the SXSWEDU.com [website](#), “Spark is a highly developed prototype that provides comprehensive resources and engaging activities for children with autism while equipping caregivers and [therapists] with collaborative monitoring and configuration tools. The application embraces the unique needs of children on the spectrum, offering a safe and enriching environment for growth and development, advancing them at the appropriate pace, while providing key data to caregivers.

“The Student Impact Challenge celebrates what youth leaders are doing to improve facets of society through projects and solutions they develop to address social, economic, and environmental issues. It also provides high school students who are making an impact in their

community with an opportunity to share their talents, validate and refine their ideas, and gain experience.”

Nandana competed against five finalists from Nigeria, Brazil, and Canada as well as Virginia and Washington. She launched her app last fall and also runs a non-profit called Autism Unity Initiative (AUI), which provides vital resources and support for individuals diagnosed with autism, as well as their caregivers.


