## South Fayette Native in Fourth Big Game



There's no home team in this Sunday's Big Game, but lots of South Fayette residents will be tuning in to see their hometown guy, Justin Watson, play in his fourth Super Bowl. Justin is a 2014 graduate of South Fayette High School and played on the 2013 PIAA Champions Lions football team.

From South Fayette, he played for the University of Pennsylvania, winning two Ivy League championships. He was also a two-time finalist for the Walter Payton Award as FCS Offensive Player of the Year.

Justin graduated from Penn's Wharton School of Business before being drafted by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2018. He won his first Super Bowl with the team in 2021. He signed with Kansas City in 2022 and has been with the team for the past two Super Bowl victories.

According to Penn's *Daily Pennsylvanian*, a win for the Chiefs this Sunday will mean that Justin has "the most Super Bowl wins by a player to come out of the Ivy League."

## Top Spellers Face Off in the Middle School

In preparation for the Scripps Spelling Bee, MS teacher Mrs. Donovan offered a written spelling test on Monday to 22 students with the intention that the student with the highest score would move on to represent SFMS at the Bee. However, the test resulted in a five-way tie of perfect scores!

On Wednesday, those five top spellers, which included sixth grader **Sameer Mohamed** and seventh graders **Oviya Yuvaraj, Ashwin Raja, Soumava Basu,** and **Diya Thirumurugan**, competed in an oral spell-off which crowned Diya as champion! Diya will now represent the district in the local spelling bee in March at Point Park University.


