As part of his acceptance to the 2024 Peace Teachers Program at the United States Institute of Peace (USIP), Dr. Yerace hosted an event during lunches at the High School today in honor of the <u>UN International Day of Peace</u> (which actually takes place tomorrow). Students were invited to participate in several activities including:

- Completing cards with what Peace means to them and their personal Peace Day Challenge
- Making origami cranes and learning the story of Sadako Sasaki and the history of peace cranes
- Creating kindness cards

The Student Government and SF BeWell groups worked with Dr. Yerace and also offered assistance in registering eligible students to vote and provided resources on conflict resolution.

There was a great turnout and many inspiring Peace cards now decorate the HS Commons.

The UN's International Day of Peace is an observance that aligns well with our district's ongoing efforts to create a more inclusive and connected environment. Established in 1981 by the United Nations General Assembly, it serves as a reminder of our shared desire for peace across nations and peoples, and it offers an opportunity for us to come together and reflect on how we can contribute to a more peaceful world.
