Summit organizers made the important decision to include youth in the event based on the realization that to truly make a difference in eradicating hate, the change needs to begin while people are young. Through annual attendance, representatives from SF have developed amazing friendships and partnerships throughout the region. A particular highlight this year was the opportunity for our students to listen to and be inspired by former US Congresswoman [Gabby Giffords](#) with her story of courage and perseverance.

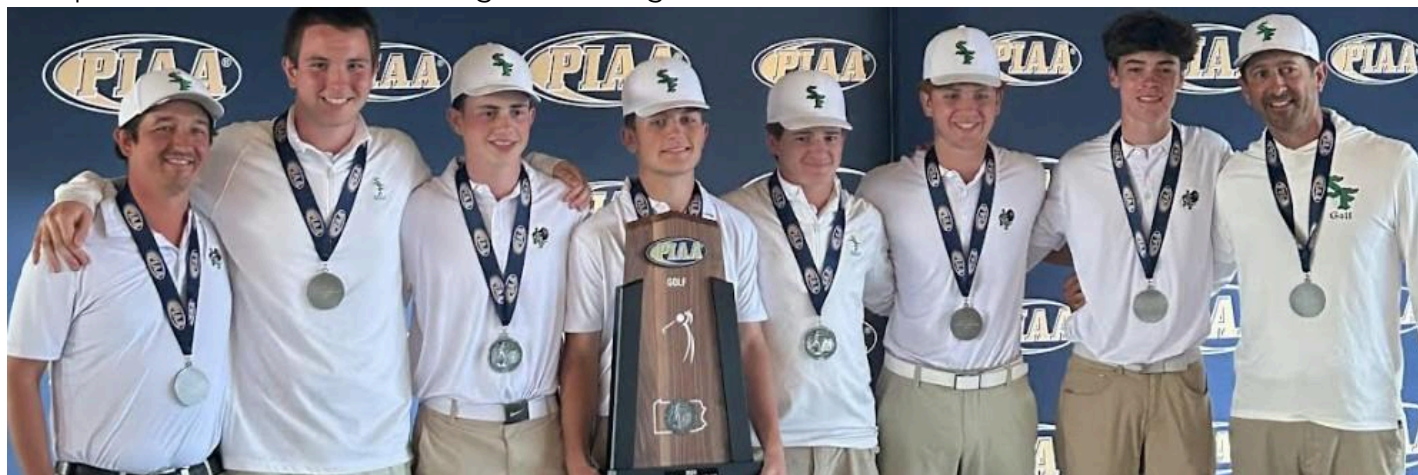

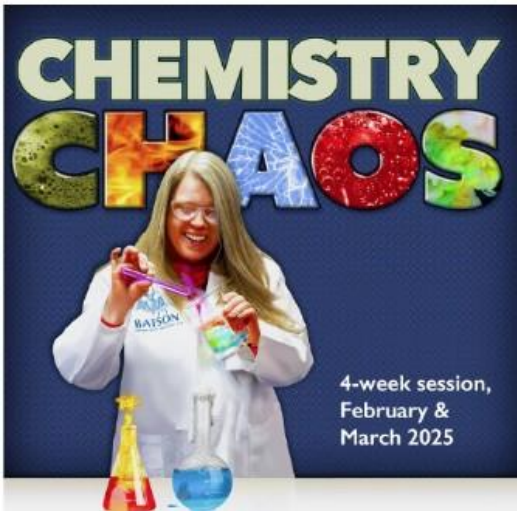
