The PIAA Board of Directors shared that they have selected **Coach Shawn Leydig** as the 2023-2024 National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS)/Pennsylvania Boys' Lacrosse Coach of the Year! This impressive honor is based upon Coach Leydig's coaching impact as well as the success of the Lacrosse program during the 2023-2024 school year. Our Lions were section champions and made it to the WPIAL Championship game as well as the state semifinals.

We also learned that Boys Varsity Basketball **Coach Dave Mislan** is being honored with a 2024 <u>Musial Award</u>.
