Detour in the District

PennDOT announced a significant detour this week that impacts our students and staff beginning Tuesday, March 25 through the remainder of the school year. The Dolphin Run bridge on Millers Run Road, between Mohawk Road and Battle Ridge Road (Route 978), is being replaced. Affected bus routes will be adjusted accordingly and impacted families are being notified by the SFTSD Transportation Team. High School and adult drivers should plan accordingly and prepare to utilize the posted detour:

West of the Bridge:


- Follow Millers Run Road (Route 978) westbound to Route 50
- Turn left onto Route 50
- Turn left onto Millers Run Road (Route 3026)
- Follow Millers Run Road back to Route 978
- End Detour

East of the Bridge:

• Same detour in reverse



Parking Changes at the Intermediate School




In preparation for the construction of an addition to the Intermediate School, the staff parking lot to the right of the building (when facing the main entrance) will be closed beginning Monday, March 31, 2025, and last for the duration of the building renovation project. As a result, the following parking adjustments will be instituted:

- The six parking spots closest to the building will be designated with signage as "Visitor Parking."
- Caregivers who pick up their children at the end of the day will also have use of the high school lot between the high school and the ES athletic field.
- All staff have been assigned to a specific parking spot in one of our three remaining parking lots: the front IS lot, the HS Innovation lot, and the IS rear lot next to the playground.

The parking changes will be in force beginning Monday, March 31, and remain in place through the end of the school year. Everyone's cooperation with these changes is greatly appreciated.
