

Taking FIRST place was the girls 4x800 meter relay team of Emily Sinton, Nina DiMartini, Siya Joshi, and Angela Zeng (a new school record at 9 minutes, 18.66 seconds). Delaney Schumaker grabbed gold in BOTH the 100m and 300m Hurdles (new school record for the 300 at 43.13 seconds)! The girls 4x400 meter relay team of Mary Claire Walsh, Ellena Gibbs, Micaella Schuler, and Delaney Schumaker took second place as did Jenson Gregorich in the pole vault (a new school record at 14'6").
