Due to the increased positive Covid-19 cases and student illnesses, the district is placing **Little Mountie AM Preschool students on remote learning beginning Tuesday, August 31, 2021. AM Preschool** students may return to in-person learning on **Tuesday, September 7, 2021.**

Cleaning of any exposed locations have been completed per approved policies and procedures. We ask for your help in maintaining a healthy environment by:

1. Check your student for COVID-19 symptoms daily. These include fatigue, muscle aches, loss of smell or taste, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, new onset severe headache, fever, chills, new uncontrolled cough, shortness of breath, and difficulty breathing. 2. If unexplained symptoms develop, your student must remain home and isolate. Do not send your student to school or extracurricular activities. Call your healthcare provider or Ashland County Health Department for directions and test for COVID-19. Please call the district nurse with test results.
3. If no symptoms develop and you have not been contacted to quarantine from exposure, your student may continue to attend school activities while following the safety plan in place.
