Any senior not attending rehearsal will have his/her name removed from the regular marching order. At rehearsal each graduate will receive **eight** tickets for use by their guests on the day of graduation. Any student who is under the influence of alcohol, drugs and/or any other dangerous substance when they report for rehearsal or graduation will not be permitted to participate. Keep in mind that the graduation ceremony is one of great tradition, and we want to make this graduation ceremony an excellent program for you, your family, and your class.
- MAY 22** Commencement (7:30 PM--Middle School Gymnasium)
You must be present in the Middle School Auxiliary Gymnasium by 6:30 PM in order to maintain your spot in the regular marching order. Make sure that you bring your cap, gown and tassel. You will not be permitted to take part in the ceremony if you put any markings on them or change them in any way prior to the ceremony. The caps are to be worn straight and flat - not on the back of your head. All students must be dressed appropriately (see below) in order to participate in the formal graduation ceremony.
LADIES: Wear a light colored dress, preferably white. Do not wear slacks or jeans. Bring bobby pins to hold your cap in place.
GENTLEMEN: Wear dress slacks, dress shoes, and a shirt and tie, preferably a white shirt. Hair should be clean and neatly combed. Caps will fit better if your hair is combed off your forehead. Do not wear tennis shoes, jeans, shorts or a shirt without a collar.
